

# CLEANING

## Leaving a tidy property

**T**he requirements on cleaning before you leave a property are very high. Cleaning is also part of the agreement and if no other arrangements have been made the property should be perfectly cleaned at the time when the new owner takes possession.

Cleaning when you move out from a property can be considered as both straining and very extensive. You have to clean away all dust, dirt and stains.

The buyer together with the seller should agree on a plan in regards to moving in and moving out. We recommend the cleaning to be done well in time before the new owner is moving in.

### Tidy Rooms

All painted areas including the space between radiator and wall should be washed.

Windows to be washed both from the inside as well as the outside, windowsills, carpentry and venetian blinds should also be cleaned.

Wardrobes including wardrobe interiors as well as the space on top of the wardrobe towards the ceiling should be tidy.

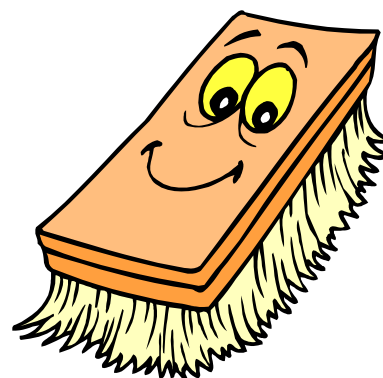
Floor, floorboards and doorsteps should be swept.

Hooks after painting and alike should be removed.

### Kitchen

Same procedure is recommended for the kitchen as described above. The ceiling should be scrubbed that is if it is painted. The stove should be wiped and polished both inside and outside and the floor and wall area behind the stove should be scrubbed as well. Lamps should be taken down and washed. The kitchen fan and ventilator should be washed both in- and outside. Refrigerator, freezer and cool cupboard should be defrosted and washed both in side as well as on the outside. Don't forget the area behind these objects.

All lockers and cupboards in the kitchen should be well cleaned.



### Scullery

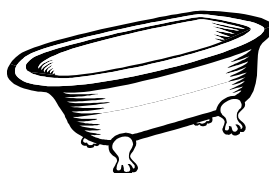
Washing machine, tumble dryer and drying cupboard and the filters should be cleaned out. Floor grains and storage spaces should also be cleared and tidy.

### Other spaces

Ought to be cleaned and cleared in the same way as described above.

### Garden and exterior

Leave the garden and exterior in such tidy way that only items are left which normally can be found in a garden. Remove all building scrap and other rubbish.



### Bathroom and WC

Bathroom cabinet and mirrors should be cleaned. Toilet seat, sink and bathtub should be carefully washed on both sides. Don't forget to clear the floor grain. Walls and floors ought to be cleaned.
